## **CHRISTMAS BONUS FOR THE UPCOMING FEBRUARY 2020 LASER REPAIR CLASS!**

**REGISTER one or more people for our February 24-March 1 2020 Laser Repair class** and get a free package of SIX online Laser Repair lectures for your other staff that can't attend the workshop, AND one Laser Safety Officer (LSO) online course. Both programs are accredited and participants receive a formal Certificate of Training.

It's always good to have more than one person trained in laser repair, but it's sometimes difficult to free them up to send to the repair course at the same time. If you can do that then we'd provide 15% off the tuition on both. If you can't do that then it's nice to have others in the department take these online lectures – the same ones that are given in the week long workshop. When your trained person comes back to the department and gets some experience under their belt with your laser maintenance, they could then start working with the others who also took the online lectures and get them up to speed on normal laser preventative maintenance.

Attendees at our Laser Repair course have always received at least one free online course to take themselves or pass to a colleague, and generally chose the Laser Safety Officer class. All facilities require an LSO and it's frequently in the Biomed department since they work with all other departments. If not then you can give this LSO class to the appropriate person in your facility. ANSI standards require formal training of Laser Safety Officers, and ANSI now recommends that they have a national Certification as LSO. This online class will make that person eligible to take an NCLC Laser Safety Officer Certification exam.

Prices have not gone up for a while on our week long laser repair class, so it's still at \$6550 for the 7-day program including 8 hotel nights, breakfasts and lunches, and one group dinner. It also includes the NCLC Laser Repair Certification exam at the end of the course. Although purchase orders are made out for the \$6550, by paying 20 days or more in advance of the course start date you can take a \$600 discount. If your budget year ends at the end of December, you may be able to use any unused training funds for this fiscal year by submitting the purchase order for training prior to the end of December (obviously varies with each hospital).
