ARE YOU COMPLIANT WITH THE CENTERS FOR MEDICAIRE & MEDICAID SERVICES (CMS) REQUIREMENT FOR LASER SERVICE? In February of 2014 CMS clarified their requirement for service on medical laser equipment through the interpretive guidelines for Hospitals. The CMS rightly points out that the FDA requires manufacturers to provide a schedule of maintenance and service adjustments and procedures to users and others upon request. This service must be performed by “**QUALIFIED**” Personnel. Getting the documented training on Laser Repair is the first step. Obtaining the NCLC Laser Certification is an additional step that helps document the Biomed’s qualifications for CMS purposes. We don’t presume to definitively guide you on CMS issues, so questions regarding the CMS equipment maintenance program requirements may be addressed to them directly at hospitalscg@cms.hhs.gov.
